Any individual having to cancel their reservation must do so by calling the reservation line (as above) within 24 hours and receive a cancellation number with no penalty.

There is an airport shuttle to these hotels but you may have to wait for a second trip or third trip as many are arriving together. It's a short wait!

CAMPGROUNDS:

There are several campgrounds and RV Parks in close proximity to the Coast High Country Inn.

1. High Country RV Park – 867-667-7445 Full Service \$25-\$43 per night. About 10 minute drive to Convention Hotel.
2. Pioneer RV Park – 867-668-5944 Full Service (no sewer) \$18-\$35 per night plus GST. 8 kms south of Whitehorse on the Alaska Highway (About 15 minute drive to Convention Hotel)
3. Cariboo RV Park -867-668-2961 Full Service \$20-\$45 per night. 21 kms south of Whitehorse on the Alaska Highway. Wolf's Den Restaurant on site – recommended** About 20 minute drive to Convention Hotel
4. Takhini Hot Springs Campground – 867-456-8004 Extra feature of Hot Springs pool (20% discount for campers) café, electricity, sani dump, water. \$20-\$37 per night. North of Whitehorse on Hotsprings Road About ½ hour from Convention Hotel.
5. Wolf Creek Campground - this is a Yukon Gov't campground, no services, firewood and water pump available, pets OK \$12/site

12 kms south of Whitehorse on the Alaska Highway – 15-20 minutes from Convention Hotel

Some of these campgrounds are closed for the season so you may get an answering service or no answer till we shake the snow and cold!
