## **Archives**

Take the time to review Archive Guidelines for League history (#601) and check out the Archives brochure (#601.b) on the national website - under resources.

Encourage parish and diocesan councils to make up a history book so that their histories can be passed down. When history books are made they should be archived at all levels including sending them to national office.

## **Elections**

Elections will soon be here and there is a revision to the *National Manual of Policy and Procedure* (P&P) that will affect those holding elections in the months ahead. On August 11<sup>th</sup> at the national executive/board meeting, a motion was adopted to revise the wording in the nomination procedure outlined on page 105,lines 8 through 12 of the P &P. the new wording is in bold below:

3. A written reply will be requested and if the member is willing to accept nomination, a brief resume of the League service and experience *shall be included as well as a letter of good standing from her pastor or spiritual advisor.* At the national level, any member allowing her name to stand for the office of president (in the case of a vacancy in the position of vice-president). Vice - President or Secretary - Treasurer shall submit with her resume a criminal records check for the purpose of volunteering with the non-vulnerable sector.

Consider having a session on how to run elections.

Thank you for ensuring your executive and nominations committee are aware of the change.
