Communiques

- 2) Do not send a national communique attached to your provincial communique. Encourage members to go to the national website. Summarize what you want to say from the national communique or take a direct quotation.
- 3) Always make sure you do not plagiarize. Put quotation marks around direct quotations or summarize in your own words.
- 4) If you read or see something that would be beneficial to another chairperson, send it to her.
- 5) Go online and see what other provinces are doing by reading their communiques.
