Variety of Postcards to Download and Send to your Member of Parliament

Are you concerned about recent Bills discussed in Parliament and In the Legislature? Are you concerned about decisions made which do not follow the teachings of the Catholic Church? Are you interested in letting your Member of Parliament (MP) and your Member of the Legislature (MLA) know how you feel about a variety of topics. A quick way to accomplish this is to download a variety of postcards, distribute them to your councils and have members write a question on them and sign their names. It takes little time and your elected officials will know how you feel. There are several different postcards which can be downloaded from the National website www.cwl.ca under Resources to help with this task. Pornography Hurts postcards are #178 with the printing instructions being #178A; Mandatory Age Verification postcards are under #179; Palliative Care postcards fall under #180 and the printing instructions for them are #180A. Postcards about Mental Health are listed under #177 with 177A being the front and 177B being the back of the postcard. Make sure to write a question to the elected official asking what they plan on doing to hopefully make these topics adhere more to the teachings of the Catholic Church.
